

We are delighted to announce that Calderdale College is offering the new technical level qualification designed by the Government and leading employers. In 2022/23 we will be teaching T Levels in Education and Childcare, Health, Digital and Business.

WHAT IS A T LEVEL?

T Levels are courses for 16 to 18 year olds that can be taken as an alternative to doing A Levels, BTECs or an Apprenticeship. They are for people who aspire to gain careers across a range of technical and vocational industry pathways. A T Level is a nationally recognised qualification that is worth the same number of UCAS points as 3 A levels.

T LEVELS PROVIDE YOU WITH:

- Technical knowledge and practical skills specific to your chosen industry or occupation.
- An industry placement (work experience) of at least 45 days in a relevant workplace.
- Maths, English and digital skills.
- Workplace and transferable skills desirable to the industry.

WHY CHOOSE A T LEVEL?

Are you a high achiever? Do you want to be at an advantage above your peers, being both qualified and experienced in your field of study? Consider a T Level. T Levels have been specifically designed to fill a shortage of both highly qualified and experienced students. They aim to open the door to skilled employment, a higher apprenticeship or

university. You could consider them as the gold-standard qualification.

YOU WILL SPEND 80% OF YOUR TIME IN COLLEGE AND 20% ON A PLACEMENT

T Levels combine classroom theory, practical learning and a 45-60 day industry placement with an employer to ensure you have real and meaningful experience of the workplace.

Studying for a T Level will give you the chance to learn what a real career is like while you continue your studies. Your industry placement will last for at least 45 days.

Industry placements allow you to improve your technical skills and become experienced in what you are learning in college in a workplace setting.
